PROGRAM

The Keysborough Senior Amateur will be played over 18 holes stroke play with a field of 55 players on Monday 18th January via a multi-tee (shot-gun) start commencing at 7.45am. A draw is attached.

REGISTRATION

All competitors are requested to report to the registration desk adjacent to the pro-shop upon arrival at the course. Players must then be present on the appropriate tee **NO LATER THAN 10 MINUTES** prior to tee time.

SCORE CARDS

All score cards are to be returned to the score board situated in the Clubhouse Bar.

DRESS REGULATIONS

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following:

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Competitors must wear long socks or white short socks with such shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

GOLF FOOTWEAR

Players are required to note that the Keysborough Golf Club does not permit metal or traditionally designed golf spikes to be worn on the course. Any player who fails to adhere to this requirement may not be permitted to play.

CLUB COURSE REGULATIONS

Sand buckets where provided **MUST** be taken and used by each player. Play will be from the tee markers as directed by the starter. Slicks or wide tyres are required on all buggies. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the Association's Code of Conduct.

SLOW PLAY

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play.

The signal for suspending play will be three short siren blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

LUNCHES

A light lunch will be available for all competitors from 11.45am in the Clubhouse. Vouchers will be given out by VGA/Club Officials upon registration.

TROPHIES & PRESENTATION

All trophies will be presented immediately after the conclusion of play. It would be appreciated if as many competitors as possible remain for the presentation to honour the respective trophy winners.
