DRAW TIMES

Please advise your partner of the start time as the draw has been sent to only one competitor of each two-person team.

REGIONAL QUALIFYING

5 pairs in the men's section, 4 pairs in the mixed section and the leading pair in the women's section will qualify for the Final. Trophies will be awarded to the winners and runners-up in the men's' and mixed sections and the winners only in the women's' section. Ties in either section will be decided by the system of countback as specified by the Australian Golf Union.

The qualifying teams will then compete in the Championship Final which will be played over 18 holes of Two-Person Team Aggregate Stableford. The final will be played at Barwon Heads Golf Club on Friday 9th July, 2010. All qualifying pairs will be forwarded a draw and player information for the Championship Final.

HANDICAPS

Competitors must play off their current Australian handicap at all times. Players shall notify the Officials present on the day of any alterations to handicaps.

REGISTRATION

All competitors are requested to report to the registration desk adjacent to the pro shop no later than 20 minutes prior to the start time.

COMPETITION TYPE

At the Regional Qualifying and Championship Final, the competition type will be a Two-Person Team - Aggregate Stableford Competition. Each player plays an individual stableford round. The Individual Stableford scores of each player in a two-person team shall then be added together to form an aggregate team score.

SCORECARDS

Scorecards at each venue are to be returned to the main scoreboard which will be located in the spike bar.

GOLF FOOTWEAR

Players are requested to note that Cranbourne Golf Club is a "soft spike" course and does not permit metal or traditionally designed golf spikes to be worn on the course. Any player who fails to adhere to this requirement will not be permitted to play.

DRESS REGULATIONS

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the host clubs dress regulations whilst participating in the event with particular reference to the following:-

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Please note that "cargo" or "board" type shorts are not acceptable. Gentlemen must wear long socks or plain short white sock (with no logos) with tailored shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be requested to leave the course. The starter has been authorised to deny any person not suitably dressed the right to play on the course.

CLUB COURSE REGULATIONS

Sand buckets where provided **MUST** be taken and used by each player. In addition, slick or wide tyres must be used on all buggies at all venues during the event. Competitors are requested to repair all divots and pitch marks whilst competing.

Any player not adhering to these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the Association's Code of Conduct.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play.

The signal for suspending play will be three short siren blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

CATERING

As outlined in the event entry form, lunch is included for all competitors. Accordingly, lunch vouchers will be given out by VGA Officials at registration. The vouchers may then be exchanged in the clubhouse for lunch. Lunches will be available from 11.00am to 2.00pm. Players will only be able to utilise their lunch vouchers during this time.

HIRE BUGGIES AND PRACTICE BALLS

At Cranbourne, pull buggies will be available at a cost of \$4.00 per buggy, whilst 5 Motorised Golf Carts are available at a cost of \$30.00. Competitors are requested to contact the pro-shop to reserve a buggy/golf cart should it be required. Practice balls are available at a cost of \$4.00 per bucket of 40 balls; \$7.00 per bucket of 70 balls and \$10.00 per bucket of 100 balls.

Competitors are permitted to ride in or on a motorised vehicle during any round of the Championship. It should be noted that the hire or provision of such transport is at the competitors own expense subject to arrangements and agreements with each host club.
