DRAW TIMES

Tee times will commence from 12.30pm. Please report to the registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to this where you will be advised your tee time.

POST ENTRIES

The Association's Match Committee has determined that Post Entries will be accepted up to and including the day of the event for the last remaining vacancies in the field. It would be appreciated if all entered competitors could convey this information to any pair contemplating entering the Championship.

REGIONAL QUALIFYING

Given the low entries received at Mortlake, the leading men's and mixed pairs will qualify for the Final and receive a trophy. Ties in either section will be decided by the system of countback as specified by Golf Australia.

The qualifying teams will then compete in the Championship Final which will be played over 18 holes of Two-Person Team Aggregate Stableford. The final will be played at Barwon Heads Golf Club on Friday 9th July, 2010. All qualifying pairs will be forwarded a draw and player information for the Championship Final.

HANDICAPS

Competitors must play off their current Australian handicap at all times. Players shall notify the Corangamite DGA Officials present on the day of any alterations to handicaps.

REGISTRATION

All competitors are requested to report to the starter at the 1st tee no later than 10 minutes prior to their tee time.

COMPETITION TYPE

At the Regional Qualifying and Championship Final, the competition type will be a Two-Person Team - Aggregate Stableford Competition. Each player plays an individual stableford round. The Individual Stableford scores of each player in a two-person team shall then be added together to form an aggregate team score.

SCORECARDS

Scorecards at each venue are to be returned to the main scoreboard which will be located in the main bar of each clubhouse.

DRESS REGULATIONS

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the host clubs dress regulations whilst participating in the event with particular reference to the following:-

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Please note that “cargo” or “board” type shorts are not acceptable. Gentlemen must wear long socks or plain short white sock (with no logos) with tailored shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie not adhering to the Host Club's dress regulations will be requested to leave the course. The starter has been authorised to deny any person not suitably dressed the right to play on the course.

CLUB COURSE REGULATIONS

Sand buckets where provided **MUST** be taken and used by each player. In addition, slick or wide tyres must be used on all buggies at all venues during the event. Competitors are requested to repair all divots and pitch marks whilst competing.

Any player not adhering to these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the Association's Code of Conduct.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play.

The signal for suspending play will be three short siren blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

CATERING

Snacks and drinks will be available at the Mortlake Clubhouse from 10.00am to 5.00pm whilst bar services will be available from 10.00am to approximately 6.00pm. Participants are welcomed in the clubhouse of all Regional Qualifying venues and are encouraged to support clubs hosting Victorian Family Championship rounds by patronising these facilities.
