CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL

The Championship Final will be played over 18 holes at the Barwon Heads Golf Club on Friday 9th July 2010. It should be noted that two "siren" starts commencing at 7.45am and 12.30pm will be utilised to start the field.

At the Final, the competition type will be a Two-Person Team - Aggregate Stableford Competition. Each player plays an individual stableford round. The Individual Stableford scores of each player in a two-person team shall then be added together to form an aggregate team score.

BARWON HEADS GOLF CLUB – ACCOMMODATION

All competitors should note that accommodation at Barwon Heads Golf Club is available for the night of Thursday 8th July. Please contact the Club reception on (03) 5255 6255 to make a reservation.

Barwon Heads offers a range of accommodation and golf packages throughout the year. The quality of the accommodation, meals and general environs at the club is outstanding. The Association encourages all participants in the Victorian Family Championship to consider staying at Barwon Heads at some point in the future. Please contact the club for further details.

TROPHY PRESENTATION

The winning pair in the Men's, Women's and Mixed Sections shall be the Victorian Family Men's, Women's and Mixed Champions respectively and shall each receive a trophy. The runners-up in each section shall also each receive a trophy.

All trophies will be presented at the Barwon Heads Golf Club following completion of play. Mixed and Women's Section trophies will be presented at around 1.00pm while the Men's Section trophies will be presented at the conclusion of play at approximately 6.00pm.

HANDICAPS

All competitors who have not previously supplied a GolfLink number with their initial entry, must produce a signed handicap card, letter or record from their home club to verify their Australian Handicap upon Registration at the Championship Final. Such verification must be signed and dated in the week preceding the final. Failure to produce such verification of handicap may lead to competitors being precluded from playing. In accordance with the event conditions, players should note that the Maximum handicap for Men is 27 and Women 45.

RULES OFFICIALS

Players are requested to note that rules officials will be moving around the course to assist with rules queries and monitor the pace of play.

PACE OF PLAY

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to pairs who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

COURSE REGISTRATION

All competitors are requested to report to the registration desk adjacent to the locker room entrance no later than 20 minutes prior to the "siren" start time.

SCORE CARDS

Scorecards are to be returned to the main scoreboard which will be located in the Bar area of the Barwon Heads Clubhouse.

DRESS REGULATIONS

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the host club dress regulations whilst participating in the event with particular reference to the following:-

- ❖ Soft spikes are permitted in the bar area. However athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar and be tucked into pants or skirts.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Please note that "cargo" / "board" type shorts or below knee length shorts are not acceptable. Gentlemen must wear long socks or plain short white socks (with no logos) with tailored shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the host club's dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie not adhering to the host club dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

GOLF FOOTWEAR

Barwon Heads prefers players not to wear metal or traditionally designed golf spikes on the course.

CLUB COURSE REGULATIONS

Sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used by each player. Competitors are requested to repair all divots and pitch marks whilst competing. Any player not adhering to these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the Association's Code of Conduct.

**** Please Note that Barwon Heads allows Distance measuring devices****

However if a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (eg, gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be three short siren blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

CATERING

Hot meals, sandwiches and snacks will be available from 11.00am to 5.00pm. In addition, Bar services will be available from 11.00am to approximately 7.00pm.

MOTORISED GOLF CARTS

Players are permitted to ride in or on a motorised golf cart during any round of the Championship. However it should be noted that players are **not** permitted to bring their own three-wheel or four-wheel motorised golf cart to Barwon Heads. Any player requiring motorised transport for the final is required to hire a cart with the club. Barwon Heads has 14 golf carts for hire at a cost of \$45. In addition, the club has 50 pull buggies for hire at a cost of \$4 per buggy.

PRACTICE BALLS

Range balls will be available at Barwon Heads and may be purchased at the pro-shop. Range Balls are the only practice balls to be used on the Practice fairway.
